

**Notice of Primary Election**

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday the 10th day of May, 2022 at the polling places in the election precincts of Thayer County, Nebraska, an election will be held. The polls will open at 8:00 a.m. and close at 8:00 p.m. All mail, precincts will have ballots mailed out to them on April 19th and will need to return them, by mail, in drop box or in person, by 8:00p.m. on Election Day for counting. Said election will be for nominating candidates to various offices. Some races will not appear on the Primary Election ballot as the number of candidates filing does not exceed twice the number of vacancies; these candidates are declared nominated and advance to the November 8, 2022 General Election
